Policy Revisions to Limit Conflicts of Interest

Why revisions to the 2008 policy?

- Practice of UC-SOM faculty participating on industry-sponsored Speakers' Bureaus adversely affects the reputation, credibility, and trust
- ProPublica Report

Policy Revisions

- *Industry COI Policy: between health care professionals and industry representatives*
- *Specific revisions from 2008 policy:*
 - Prohibit Speakers' Bureau activity by SOM faculty
 - Defined as compensation for speaking engagements, whether one-time or recurring
 - Exempt honoraria is permitted and limited to invited visiting professorships or grand rounds at universities or other non-profit entities, service to the NIH or other government agencies or accredited Continuing Medical Education functions

COI Policy Still Allows

Compensation for research or clinical consulting, data safety management, or dissemination of data from research or clinical trials with that contracting being done through UPI or the University.
