Rose Family Medicine Residency


- Received STFM/AAFP Family Practice Management Award for Practice Improvement

- Electronic PDF version available for \$25






Jack Spittler, MD – PGY2, UH Residency

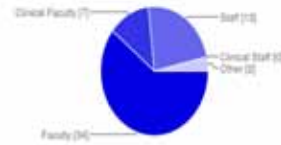

SCO Survey

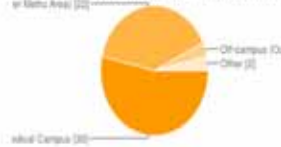

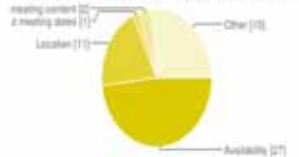

How often do you attend DFM quarterly meetings (March, June, September, December)?

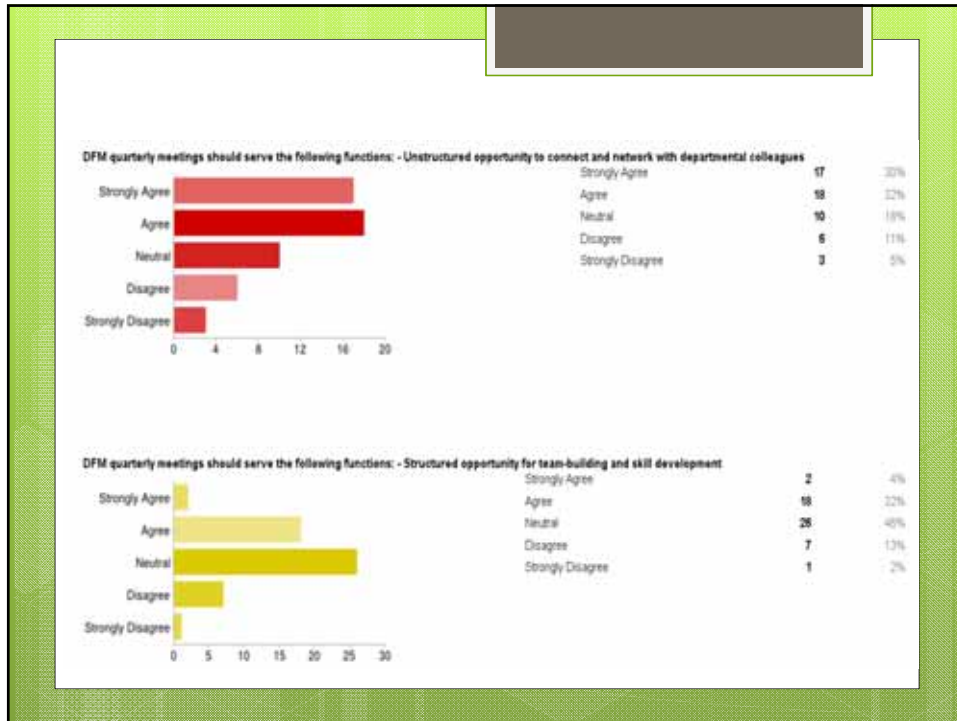


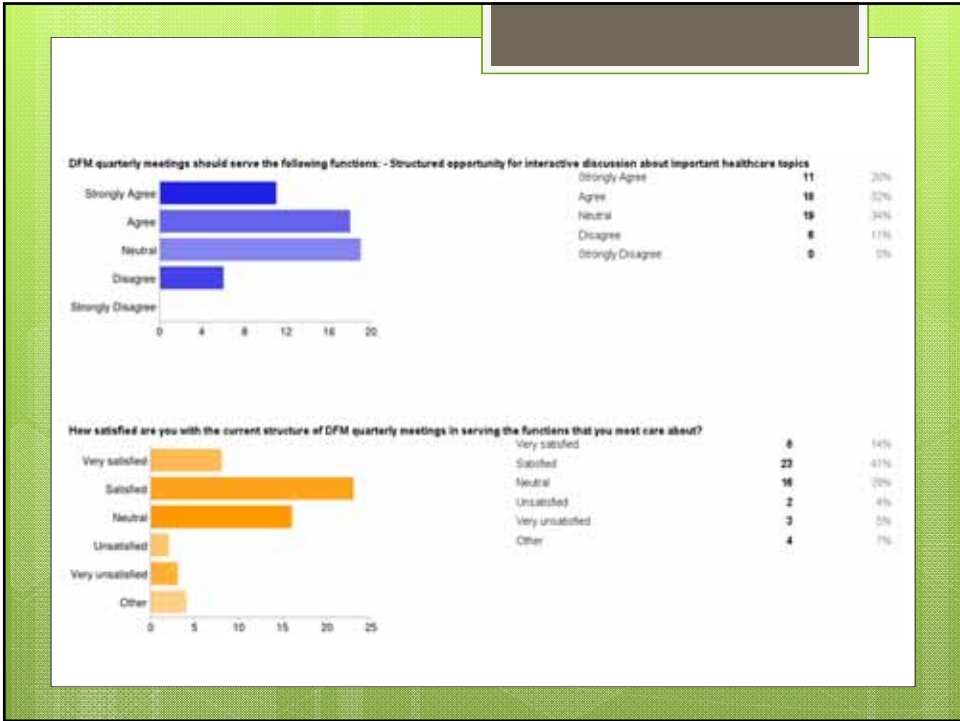
